

## **Information Paper**

1. Subject: Civilian Clothing Allowance
2. REF: DoD Financial Management Regulation (7000.14-R), Volume 7A, Chapter 29, "Clothing Monetary Allowances, Feb 2002 (attached).  
  
2. IAW paragraph 290403, service members (officers and enlisted) directed to dress in civilian clothing more than half the time when performing official duty may be authorized a civilian clothing allowance (if Permanent Duty Station is outside the United States). The Permanent Duty Civilian Clothing Allowance has 2 parts, the Initial Civilian Clothing Allowance (ICCA) and the Replacement Civilian Clothing Allowance (RCCA). The ICCA is paid not more than once in any 3-year period. The RCCA is paid at the end of the anniversary month of the member starting the qualifying assignment if it is projected that the member will serve at least 6 additional months in that assignment.
3. Civilian clothing allowances as of Feb 2002 are provided on page 29-16 of the Reference.
